To all Parents and Guardians:

I have received several calls today about swine flu in the schools. All of the Hoboken public schools remain open and are functioning normally. We continue to monitor the absenteeism and the reasons students miss school. We are doing so in conjunction with the Hoboken Health Department. The current recommendation from the Center for Disease Control is that anyone experiencing flu-like symptoms (fever greater than 100 degrees along with sore throat and/or cough) must remain out of school for seven days. If students are in school with flu-like symptoms they will be sent home from school and not allowed to return for seven days. In addition, when any students return to school after an absence the nurse will confirm that they have no flu-like symptoms.

We will continue to keep you updated. The health and safety of our students remains our number one concern. Thank you for your cooperation and support.
